## Basic Services of Funeral Directors, Staff and Overhead.....\*\$1,800.00

Our professional services charge include but is not limited to consultation with family and others; coordinating services plans with cemetery, crematory, clergy and other involved parties; personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial calls; administration and record keeping; preparing and filing Virginia death certificates; normal operating expenses to include taxes, licensures, permits, utilities, legal fees, insurances, salaries, government compliances and normal business operations.

This fee for our basic funeral service and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

### Cremation Services - Ranging from \$2,705.00-\$8,565.00

Direct Cremation: The charge for a direct cremation includes Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, Local Transfer of the deceased to funeral home, Crematory fee (\$405.00) & Medical Examiner's fee (\$100.00 — State Law). **State and local laws do not require a casket for direct cremation.** 

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are of cardboard, composite or wood material.
